Opportunity for Citizens/Visitors to Speak

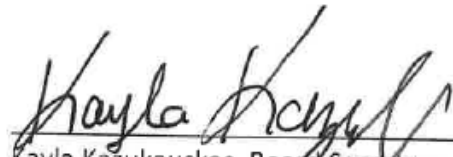

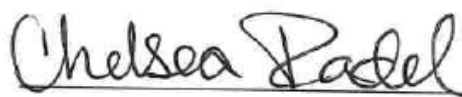

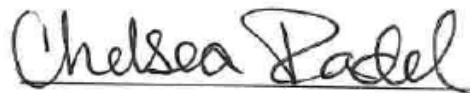
